11/6 CREATION ORIGINAL SIN

Move away from the simplistic understanding of Creation to an adult perspective on the incredible master plan for the human race.

He did not say "I am <u>one of many truths</u>". He said <u>"I am the Truth."</u>

<u>Truth is a person</u>. Jesus Christ. Our Supreme Teacher.

11/20 JESUS: REDEEMER JESUS: RESURRECTION

Why was it <u>necessary</u> that Christ suffer and die on the Cross? It couldn't be worked out some other way? Get clear answers to this fundamental aspect of our Faith.

Some believe that all that is required 'to be saved' is to "accept Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior". Others think that it doesn't matter what you believe or do as long as you are "basically a good person". Still others dismiss the idea of "salvation" entirely. Catholics all too often entirely disregard not only the requirements for salvation but the absolute realities of Purgatory and Hell and lack the understanding that it is we, not God, that brings us to either of those states.

What is the accurate assessment of the situation and what is, in fact, required of us? How does Redemption operate for the entire human race, baptized and unbaptized?

In this class, we dive, as well, into the absolute historical and theological reality of Christ having been raised from the dead. It is this reality that <u>authentically empowers us to stand firm in a world where despair and apparent failure control the actions of many</u>
